EUROPASSION in ESPARREGUERA (Spain) March 3 – 6 2022

After the arrival of the participants on Thursday evening in the porch of the Esparreguera Passion Theater (40 km west from Barcelona), Secretary General Josef Lang welcomed 32 groups from 13 countries with 128 participants.



On Friday morning, representatives of the Europassion Board, representatives of the Esparreguera Passion Play and representatives of the Federation of Catalan Passion Play Venues were received by Archbishop Joan Josep Omella in the Bishop's Palace of Barcelona.











A visit then took place to the Parliament of Catalonia, where the delegation was welcomed by President Mrs. Laura Borrás.





The other participants visited the city of Manresa, where 500 years ago St. Ignatius of Loyola had his



mystical and spiritual experience that led him to write his work on the Spiritual Exercises and found the Society of Jesus (the Jesuit Order) years later.

The Basilica of Santa Maria dominates the cityscape.




In the afternoon all participants have lunch in Montserrat – Benedictinian monk from the monastery talks about how the Passion is portrayed today.

On Saturday morning, the delegates gathered for the General Assembly of Europassion in the Passion Theather.







After the welcome by the representative of the Europassion, Jordi Ros, and the reading of a greeting from the Holy Father Francisco I, the President of the Passion Play of Esparreguera and the President of the Federation of Catalan Passion Play Venues brought greetings to the assembly.

Yves Feuvrier from Loudeac, the only contemporary witness from 1982, reports on the start of the Europassion in 1982. The idea of the Europassion was born at a meeting of the Passion Play cities Loudeac, Masevaux, Nancy (F), Olesa de Montserrat, Ulldecona and Esparreguera (ES) in Montserrat.



According to the reports of the members of the Board of Directors, a resolution on the war events in Ukraine was adopted by the General Assembly, which will be sent to the European Commission and to the members of the European Parliament.

After the presentation of the new members Llinars (ES), Grossenlüder, Kleinenberg, Dammbach (DE) and Nettuno (IT), the need to amend the Statutes of the Europassion was pointed out and 2 cash auditors and a three-person election committee were appointed.

Josef Lang handed Jordi Ros 100 years old wooden cross on the occasion of 40 years of the Europassion.

Miroslav Kutlák invited to the Europassion 2023 in Horice na Šumave in the Czech Republic (8. - 11. 6. 2023)






During the General Assembly, the accompanying persons took part in a guided tour of Esparreguera (Bell Tower, Church of St. Eulàlia, Pottery Museum).









In the late afternoon, before the performance of the Passion Play, performances of Catalan folk culture take place in front of Passion Theathre.
















